Thank you for contacting the National Personnel Records Center. 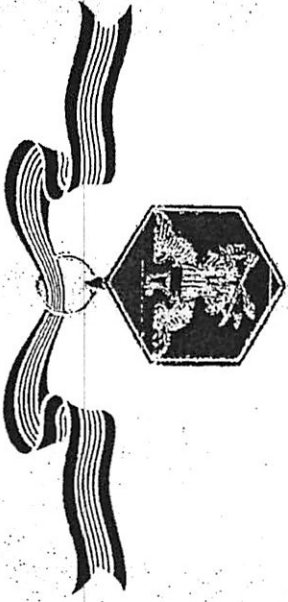

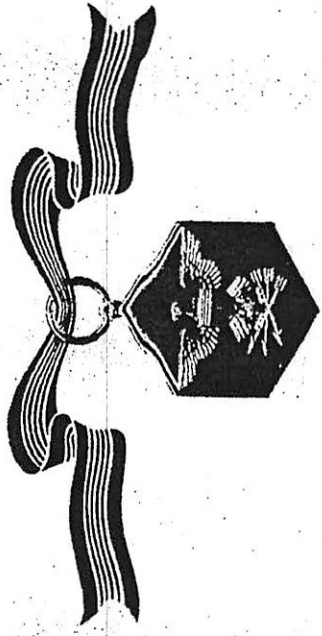

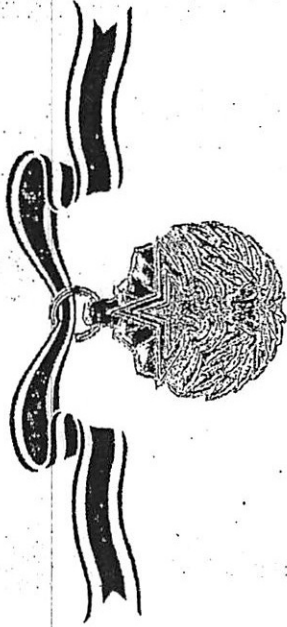
